PROCEED WITH CAUTION—MINISTER CYNTRIA LYONS

- 1. God is still the same. We've changed. The year has changed.
- 2. We must be prepared for anything. Stay on guard. Be alert. Watch & pray.
- 3. We are closing our eyes to so much, but God is still watching.
- 4. We are entering a season of prayer and uncovering.
 - A. Those that talk to Him regularly won't be shocked.

Romans 12:12 NIV "Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

- 5. More churches will close this year.
- Some leaders have placed the burden of pastoring on themselves.
 - They haven't been called, they're simply captivating
 - People love a show.
- The tides are turning. People are about to start longing for the "truth."
- They're neglecting the responsibilities of the pastor:
 - Shepherding the flock
 - Teaching and preaching the Word of God
 - Providing spiritual guidance
 - Caring for the needs of the congregation
- 6. Don't eat at everyone's table.
 - A. He Gave them pastors after "His" heart
 - B. Your leader will know what to feed you.
 - 1. Some leaders aren't qualified to feed the people.
 - 2. You can't scale and debone the fish (the Word of God) before serving it. Otherwise it takes away the sting and the stab of conviction that the Word provides.
 - 3. The flip side of that is that you have babes in Christ that can't handle the bones, so you will have to debone, break down, have Bible Studies and Bible classes, check on them, see about them.
 - 4. Folks are dying spiritually from choking on the little bones.
 - 5. Leaders must do more than "Preach and jump around."
- 7. Note to the pews: If you have a problem with your leader(s) knowing what's going on in your life, find a new ministry.
 - A. Don't sit under people you can't trust
- 8. Leaders, you cannot create your own rendition of the word, "just for your people."
 - A. Then they're only equipped to fight the battles created in your respective church.
- 9. Satan's not going to stop.
 - A. He knows what his job is.
 - B. As the church, we have to make sure we're not helping him.
- 10. Love everyone (not just in Word, but in deed)
 - A. Churches are full of everything but love.
 - B. The love of God must be felt coming through the door of the church.
 - 1. The world is so void of "real love." When people come to the church, they want to feel something genuine and different from what they experience in the world.

PLEASE READ: Galatians 6:10 KJV-Isaiah 40:29-31 KJV- Psalm 103 KJV-Psalm 34:17 HIGHLIGHTS:

Genuine love doesn't require that we compromise what we teach or believe.

Remember, sometimes people need to be "taught" how to be loved (ie., the abused).

Don't give your enemy time to recover! God has already taken care of what's before you. Be on time in the assignment!

Some of us feel like we just made it out of 2023, but by God's grace and His will, we will begin 2024 in about 14 hours.

PASTOR WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT & STATE OF THE MINISTRY - PASTOR STEPHEN & CYNTRIA LYONS

Welcome to the New Year – 2024! God brought us through 2023 and has allowed us to see a brand new year. What does God have in store for you this year? I don't know exactly, but God knows and it's up to you to remain faithful and focused, so you know. What I do know is that God's plan is perfect and that what He has in store for us this year is good and it's better than our past.

I started this year with the message "Maintaining the Right Perspective: Going Through Hard Times with Him." James wrote in James 1:3 & 4, "For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing." Our faith will be tested this year, but James reminds us that when our faith is tested it's given the opportunity to grow. We'll never go through trials in life without also gaining access to opportunities. Anytime you go through, tell yourself there must also be an opportunity in this. Ask God to open your eyes to see the opportunity in the midst of what you're going through.

Test and trials in our lives help mature us and develop us into the masterpieces God created us to be. **Ephesians 2:10** reads, "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago." We have been uniquely created and positioned by God to fulfill the plan and purpose of God. So, anytime you find yourself going through, remind yourself, "I've been uniquely and especially created by God to go through this. He has strategically placed me where I am for His divine purpose and to fulfil His divine will. If He created me for this than I will get through this."

Saints of God, this is not the time to lose focus or to walk around with the wrong perspective. The wrong focus and perspective cause us to waste time and fall behind. Get up and get to moving in 2024!

For 2024 we will continue raising funds towards our building campaign. Thank you to all those who made and paid pledges in 2023. We received an initial 2023 pledge amount of \$5,800, but we ended up raising \$6,700 in pledges (\$900 over our pledge amount). We still need to raise and put down \$150,000 in cash to secure our building loan. We are currently at \$60,000. This means we need to raise \$90,000. We have a long way to go, but we also have a pathway to get there. In March we will kick-off our 2024 Pledge Campaign. This Pledge Campaign will run through October 1, 2024. We hope you will consider making a pledge.

We also welcome personal loans that individuals would like to make towards our building goal. If you're interested in lending ELCC funds especially for our building project, please <u>reach out to us</u>. All loans will be documented and notarized.

So, where are we in the building process? Below is a tentative building project timeline. Dates are estimated target dates and may change. I will update the timeline accordingly in our quarterly newsletters.
