

PASTOR WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT & STATE OF THE MINISTRY - PASTOR STEPHEN & CYNTRIA LYONS

Let me start off by saying, what a mighty good God we serve! I praise God today because I'm literally witnessing God redeem the time and expedite some major things for our ministry. The biggest and MOST exciting news I'm pleased and proud to share today is that we not only reached our \$150,000 goal, but we've surpassed it! I'm reminded of what Paul wrote to the Christians in Ephesus in Ephesians 5:20 (NLT),

"Now all glory to God, who is able; through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think. Glory to him in the church and in Christ Jesus through all generations forever and ever! Amen."

ALL GLORY TO GOD! God has not only been working in His people, but He's blessing His people; and I'm witnessing saints be not only obedient to the Spirit of God in their giving, but good stewards over what God has placed in their hands. In March and April, we had several very generous and kind donors cut checks to ELCC. Their obedience has made what should have taken a year and a half to accomplish, happen in one month. God's mighty power is at work, and we are witnessing God perform miracles in the lives of His people and through this ministry.

So, what's next? We are working to secure funding for construction and obtain final approval on the site and building plans. We will continue with our 2024 Pledge Campaign started in March. It will run through October 1, 2024. We don't know what the final cost of the building will be or what exactly we'll need once we move in, so we will continue raising funds and hope you will consider making a pledge.

In the last newsletter, I mentioned that we would welcome personal loans that individuals would like to make towards our building goal. At this point, we are no longer in need of personal loans from individuals. God has met the current need, and we are grateful to Him for this.
