

On Tuesday, January 24th our Engineer and Architect presented our Site Plan and current building plan to the Town of Fuquay-Varina in a Pre-submittal Meeting. The Committee reviewed the plan and provided us with feedback in April. The Engineer and Architect are working on the plan updates and resubmittal of the drawings. We're hoping by June we'll receive final approval on the site plan and by the end of September our building renderings will be approved.

In the meantime, we plan to have at least one event on the church's land in 2023. A BIG thanks to Deacon Bryant who added rocks to the unpaved land driveway. We're hoping this will make it easier for vehicles to access the church's land.

In April we started another Pledge Drive. This pledge will run through the end of September.

Please let us know if you're interested in contributing towards our 2023 Pledge Drive. We're believing God that we will reach our \$65,000 Building Fund Goal by end of December 2023.

You can be part of helping us accomplish this goal. We're already half-way there!
