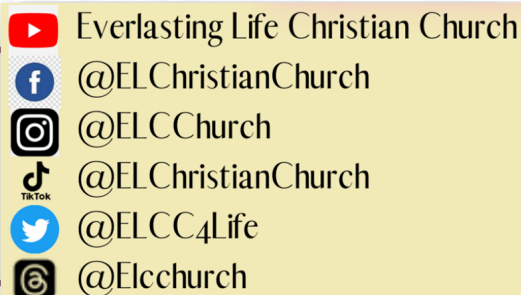
### OUR MISSION

## DEAR PEOPLE OF GOD - READ YOUR BIBLE!



If you are seeking refuge, peace, healing, prosperity, or love, read your Bible! Of course, those aren't the only things you will find. You will also find Jesus, from Genesis to Revelation. He's been there since the beginning and now sits on the right hand of the Father, making intercession for us! (John 1)

The Apostle Paul writes in Ephesians 1:17-23 (NIV) which says, "I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know Him better. 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in His holy people, 19 and His incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength 20 He exerted when He raised Christ from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms, 21 far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. 22 And God placed all things under His feet and appointed Him to be head over everything for the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills everything in every way." As often as you need to be reminded, read this verse, and many others. The Word of God, the Bible, is bread and water, inspired by God. Reading should spark the fire inside to burn even the more! Jeremiah 20:9, where the prophet describes God's Word being like a fire in his bones, and Acts 2:3, where the Holy Spirit descends as tongues of fire. The more you eat, the more you'll desire, and the more you'll share the Gospel with others.

The Holy Spirit (Spirit of God) is available for you. That's why Jesus came, so that You will have the Comforter, the Holy Spirit (John 14:26), and life more abundantly (John 10:10), beyond what we can feel with our hands. Ask, our Father will answer.

Hi Saints, I pray each of you are doing well and living a life pleasing to God. A lot has happened since our last newsletter. Our children, along with the Youth of Unity Outreach Recreational Ministry led Sunday morning worship the last Sunday in March. The children sang a few songs and Dallas IV, Kai, and Matthew ministered for the first time. They were well prepared and delivered inspiring messages. It is good to see our children excited about the opportunity to serve and lift up the name of Jesus!

In May, we had the privilege and honor of celebrating Pastor Bryant 25 years of service to Unity Outreach and the Shawtown Community. She has changed and transformed so many lives over 25 years. What sticks out the most to me is the impact and influence she had on the lives of so many leaders in the Body of Christ. She is a true example of integrity and Christlike Character. We pray that God continues to keep her and strengthen her in the years to come.

In May we also held our groundbreaking ceremony. Several came out to take part in this momentous occasion, including some of our friends from Unity Outreach in Lillington. It was a wet day, but we were able to bless the land and dedicate the forthcoming building to the Lord before it started raining. This ceremony was super uplifting and encouraging for the Body of ELCC. Many begin to see the vision and see themselves in the vision.

Right now, construction has been put on hold as we are working with the utility company to move some fiber optic cables buried at the front of our property, and work with our Engineer and the Town of Fuquay to move the building and parking lot out of flood prone soils (this will potentially save us hundreds of thousands of dollars in site costs).

Despite these challenges, I bless God because he continues to show Himself strong in our situation. We recently found out from the utility company that we will not have to cover the cost of moving the fiber optic cables (the utility company will bear the thousands of dollars in cost to move these cables). Now we're just waiting approval from the town on our revised site plans before we can get back to work. We've seen God move time, after time, after time again, and we expect nothing less this go round!

In June, I had the opportunity to minister at First Missionary Baptist Church in Siler City for their Sunday Youth Service (the home church of our very own Cassie Lyons). That morning the house was full of young people. It brought me joy sharing my testimony and the Gospel of Jesus Christ with this generation. I also found out how talented and smart the youth of First Missionary Baptist Church are. The future is very bright for these youth!

We wrap this quarter up with our ELCC Scholarship Banquet on Saturday, June 28 from 2:30pm-5:30pm at Evangel Church located at 201 Meadow Dr., Fuquay-Varina, NC. I am proud and pleased to announce that we are awarding a scholarship this year and recognizing our hardworking and talented youth at the banquet. To date, we have awarded over \$13,000 in scholarships since 2016. You are invited to join us for this day of celebration and recognition. The banquet is free, food will be served, and dress is informal.
