A: To keep you, leaders, members, and donors, informed on events, to encourage you, and share the Good News of Jesus Christ.



HAPPY NEW YEAR Saints of God! Out with the old...in with the new, new!

2022 was a fruitful and productive year for ELCC. Thanks to our Leadership Team and congregation, we ended the year on a high note! One accomplishment I'm super proud of is the local family of 5 we adopted for Christmas. Within a week of adopting the family we were able to get them everything on their wish list and more. What really touched me is when we asked the mother what she wanted for Christmas she said, "I just want to be saved." I am pleased to share; she accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior and has connected with a local Body of Believers. We have committed to staying in touch with the family and helping in any way we can. Thank you to Minister Carrie Wilson and Evangelist Sophia Bouknight for leading this charge and organizing the meet-up with the family; and to all the Saints who contributed to this Outreach effort.

In August 2022 we began a 6-month pledge to help us more quickly reach our \$100,000 Building Fund Goal. Our goal was to raise an additional \$8,000 on top of what we normally take in during this same period. I'm pleased to say that as of end of December, we surpassed this goal and still have one more month left to go. We will know our final tally once all pledges are received. If you didn't participate in our 2022 pledge, no worries, we will begin a new Pledge Drive in March that will run until end of August. We invite you to join us in this Pledge Drive as we work towards our year-end goal of \$65,000. Whether you make a pledge or not, we encourage you to sow into ELCC's ground. Your liberal, tax deductible giving, ensures the ministry continues to operate and fulfill the will of God.

Our next Leadership Meeting will be Sunday, February 5 @ 11:30am. I'm asking all Ministers, Elders, Deacons, and Overseer to attend. Our Annual Church Meeting will be held Sunday, February 19 at 11:30am. Attendance will be in person, but virtual attendance is available via Zoom for either of these meetings. If you'd like to attend virtually and do not have our Zoom credentials, please let us know so we can get the information to you. Join us at our Annual Church Meeting to learn more about our 2022 Accomplishments, Current Year Plans and Goals, and Future Plans and Goals (you do not have to be a member to join us).

On Tuesday, January 24 our Engineer will present our Site Plan to the Town of Fuquay-Varina in a Pre-submittal Meeting. The Committee attending this meeting will review the plan and provide comments on it. The goal of this meeting is to obtain the Committee's approval on the plan so we can submit it to the Town Board for formal approval. We're believing God that by the end of this quarter we'll have our site plans approved so we can move forward with our building plan approval.

Here's a quick look at our 2023 Church Goals:

- Obtain Site Plan Permit Town of Fuguay-Varina Board Approval
- Obtain Building Permit Town of Fuquay-Varina Board Approval
- Reach Building Fund Goal of \$65,000
- Obtain Building Loan
