On behalf of Everlasting Life Christian Church, your donations and support made this possible.



"STAY CONNECTED TO THE SOURCE"

Recently, I got two of my wisdom teeth drilled down. Unfortunately, they both were too close to the nerve to get them completely removed. During the healing process, a part of one tooth broke off in my gums. When I went back for a check up, the dentist told me he had to go back in to take the chipped tooth out. I didn't want him to go back in, especially while being awake, but if he didn't I would risk my condition getting worse. Meaning, I would be in pain, and the chipped tooth could cause an infection.

In this moment God spoke to me and said,

"A tooth disconnected in the gums can cause infection. A tooth connected in the gums gives your tooth stability, and serves a purpose.

A piece misplaced can cause infection instead of protection. Disconnected pieces promote fragility instead of stability."

Although it was a piece of tooth, inside the mouth, even inside the gums, it couldn't serve a purpose because it wasn't connected. How many of us have wrongfully assumed we are serving our purpose because we've identified who we are, and we are in the right environment? Connected parts of the body naturally experience wear and tear, they are tested and they are used.

Romans 12:4-5 says it like this:

"For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another."

The church is an organism. We should, to some extent, be dependent on one another to accomplish a common goal. If you are not working, yet find yourself sitting in the right atmosphere, I challenge you to get connected. If you sit too long, disconnected you may find yourself malnourished (externally), and discouraged (internally). Nourishment is a result of connection. That tooth fragment was a risk instead of a benefit because it wasn't connected to the system which nourishes it.

We are half-way through 2022 and the progress we have made is both tangible and inspirational! I am proud and pleased to announce that we've signed contracts with Steve Hall Architecture, PLLC and The Curry Engineering Group, PLLC. Steve Hall is working on our building design and permitting from the Town of Fuquay-Varina, while Don Curry is working to complete our Site Plan and obtain approval from the Town on it. None of this is cheap! We are looking at a total cost of \$45,000 for these services, but because of your liberal giving we have the funds in hand to cover these costs. - Sign agreement with Contractor
- Receive Building & Site Plan Permits from the Town of Fuquay-Varina
